

## Dedicated COVID hospital at SCB inaugurated on 27.10.2020



A dedicated Covid-19 facility on the premises of SCB Medical College and Hospital was inaugurated on 27.10.2020. Revenue Divisional Commissioner (RDC), Central Division, Sri Anil Kumar Samal inaugurated the 500-bed facility offering healthcare service towards isolation and treatment of moderate to severe patients. The Covid hospital also has Obstetrics and Surgery wings.

The SCB Covid Hospital consisting of three buildings (two from the ophthalmology department and the other one from new medicine building) has 50 intensive care units (ICUs), ventilators and 30 high dependency units (HDUs).

At present, over 100 patients are undergoing treatment at SCB and around 30 of them are in ICUs, informed State Nodal Officer for Covid-19 training Prof Jayant Panda. Among others, Cuttack Collector Sri Bhabani Shankar Chayani, CMC Commissioner Smt. Ananya Das, SCB Dean & Principal and different Heads of the Department, staffs and nurses were present during the inauguration.
